ETH-Zurich has an institutional [Read-and-Publish agreement with the American Meteorological Society \(AMS\)](#) covering all AMS journals including the *Bulletin of the American Meteorological Society (BAMS)*.

Corresponding authors affiliated with ETH-Zurich **will not be charged publishing fees** (e.g., page charges, open-access fees, or any other fees) for manuscripts where the initial submission date falls within the agreement period (January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027).

To qualify: Corresponding authors must use their ETH-Zurich email address and ETH-Zurich affiliation when submitting manuscripts, and must list ETH-Zurich as an affiliation on the final published version of the accepted paper in order for the agreement to apply. All papers published under this agreement will be made openly available upon publication under the Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY 4.0 license).

Author instructions: ETH-Zurich authors interested in submitting manuscripts to AMS journals should review the information on the [AMS Author Information webpage](#). This page includes links to AMS journal scopes and article types, submission formatting requirements, Word and LaTeX manuscript templates, AMS ethical policies, and the steps from submission to final publication.

As part of the manuscript submission process, ETH-Zurich authors will be prompted by the AMS Editorial Manager submission system to indicate that their manuscript falls under the ETH-Zurich read-and-publish agreement.

Summary: Quick Tips for ETH-Zurich Authors

- ✓ Always use your ETH-Zurich **email and affiliation** for submission to qualify for the read-and-publish benefit.
- ✓ Consult AMS [author information](#) for templates and detailed instructions before preparing your manuscript.
- ✓ Check individual journal pages for [specific requirements](#) (e.g., article types, word limits).
- ✓ Plan submissions early to accommodate peer review timelines.
